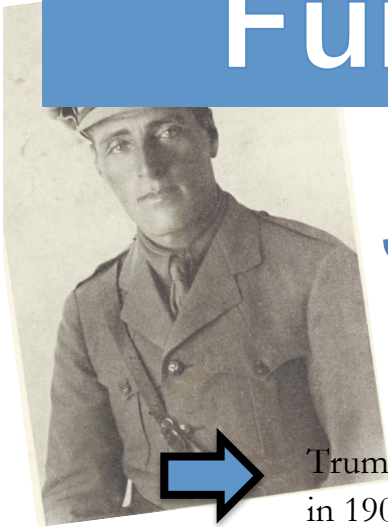


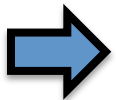
Fun Facts About...

Josef Trumpeldor

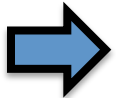
1880-1920



Trumpeldor lost his left arm during battle in the Russian-Japanese War in 1902.



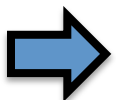
In 1912, Trumpeldor made aliyah to Palestine and lived for a while at Kibbutz Degania.



Trumpeldor was the founder of He-Halutz, a pioneering youth organization that prepared youngsters for settlement in Eretz Yisrael.



In 1920, Trumpeldor was involved in the defense of Tel Hai against Arab attacks. During this battle, Trumpeldor was fatally wounded.



Supposedly, on his deathbed, Trumpeldor said, “Tov lamut be’ad artzeinu. Never mind, it is good to die for one’s country.”
